## ORPHAN SUPPORT

Quality Education is Sustainable Development Goal No.4 which is the foundation to creating sustainable development and this program is aimed at helping the needy orphans to access quality education and necessary material to ensure their full participation in learning. Supports provided include scholastic materials, establishment of learning center for free primary education, health screening, psychosocial support and social upliftment through extracurricular activities. The global outbreak of Covid-19 has affected education system in Kenya, Somalia, Uganda and Tanzania where we have our sponsored students. Schools across the countries break for 7 months and students were learning from home.

**Home and school visits:** This activity mainly targets monitoring students' education progress and wellbeing. This year social organizers across Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania and Somalia ensured the effective implementation of this activity.



**Food packages distribution:** OSP Africa carried out quarterly food distribution exercise for sponsored students across all clusters in Kenya, Tanzania, Somalia and Uganda. The target was to provide families with regular meals throughout the year.



**Quran Competitions:** OSP team in Kenya, Somalia, Uganda and Tanzania organized Annual Qur'an competition which was aimed at enhancing a desire and habit to read Quran for sponsored students to encourage them to learn and recite Qur'an in the manner taught by the Prophet (S.A.W). The best students were recognized and awarded.

**Sanitary towels distribution and Hygiene kits:** Field officers from Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania conducted the distribution exercise across all the clusters to reduce girls avoid absenteeism cases.

Distribution of hygiene kits activity was aimed at creating awareness and promotion of personal hygiene and sanitation. Orphan students were given hygiene kits that comprised of soap, tooth paste, tooth brush, Vaseline, comb, nail cutter to improve their health.



## WATER FOR LIFE

Water for Life program is tailored to sustainable development goal No.6 (Clean water & sanitation) towards improving access to clean drinking water. The program involved constructions of shallow wells, boreholes and water reserves to support drought affected communities. HHRD Supports and strengthens the participation of local communities in improving water and sanitation management.

This year, HHRD has constructed a total of 74 water wells in Kenya where over 94,000 individuals have benefited, 20 in Tanzania with over 23,700 beneficiaries, 27 in Somalia benefiting over 35,100 people and 20 in Uganda with over 26,100 beneficiaries.



## WATER, SANITATION and HYGIENE (WASH)

At least 892 million people continue to practice open defecation according to facts in sustainable development goal No.6 (Clean water & sanitation). This program is geared towards construction and renovation of public toilets in areas with limited access to proper hygiene conditions, especially in schools, hospitals and other social amenities (public toilets).

HHRD has constructed and repaired a total of 8 latrines in schools across Kenya, Somalia, Tanzania and Uganda to benefit over 8,500 individuals.

## SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND LIVELIHOOD

The program is designed for the socio-economic development of people with focus on women and youth from vulnerable and less fortunate communities. It embodies sustainable development goal No. 1 of eradicating poverty among the most neglected segment of society. HHRD Skills Development and Livelihood (SD&LP) Centre's empowers students in Tailoring & embroidery, ICT training and Henna & Cooking skills. HHRD has Centers in Kenya and Somalia which has recorded a total of 421 students enrolled during the year.

During the year, Program officer, Mr. Abdirahman Mohamed conducted several monitoring visit to the Centre's to motivate learners & ensure weekly program deliverables are met. He also conducted various visits on individuals awarded with the gifts to check on their progress.



## HEALTHCARE AND NUTRITION

Healthcare and Nutrition Program seeks to reduce the burden of disease in Africa by supporting the role of local health systems to offer free eye medical care mainly targeting cataract patients. Focusing on the needy segment of the population, HHRD holds Eye Camps throughout the year.

This year, HHRD conducted eye camp surgeries in two countries in Africa.
