Eid-UI-Adha, the feast of sacrifice, is one of the most beautiful times in the whole year. In the year 2021 HHRD implemented Udhiya Program by sacrificing animals, i.e Cows and Goats to enable the less privileged in the society to have a chance to celebrate Eid-UI-Adha with fellow Muslims. More than 150,000 people benefited including widows, children, orphans, destitute, old aged people, disabled, and refugee families.

The Prophet (PBUH) said, "Show mercy on the people of Earth and the One above the heavens will show mercy upon you." (Tirmidhi) Alhamdulillah. Families who rarely eat meat due to financial inability were able to not only feast on Eid but also save shares of meat for weeks to come.

WATER FOR LIFE

Water for Life Program's goal is to reach out to communities in water scarce areas to acquire safe drinking water points.

The approaches to engage the community in need of safe drinking water & provide them necessary tools & skills of maintaining the water wells constructed for sustainability.

Our team in Tanzania inaugurated 3 water wells in Homboza Primary school, Msimbu primary school & Msikiti kwa Runyembwa in Pwani Region where over 6,000 people are expected to benefit.



SKILLS DEVELOPMENT & LIVELIHOOD

The program is aimed at training youths on computer, tailoring and henna skills. One of the main objectives of the program is to introduce skill training to both rural and urban poor populations for their participation in economic development for self-sustainability and acquire life-skills for full integration in the country's development.



Sheikh Abu Hamza, one of the leading Muslim Scholars in Kenya graced a life skills and character building session in Nairobi Skills Development & Livelihood Centre. Among the topics discussed were importance of discipline, teamwork & goal setting



WASH

Students at Kibera primary school in Nairobi, Kenya will benefit from modern latrine facility which was officially handed over to the institution.

HHRD team urged the beneficiaries to maintain and utilize the facilities to realize improved sanitation.

The facilities also have hand washing area to promote personal hygiene.



The team also carried out Hygiene promotion sessions for students at Kibera Primary School. We demonstrated proper hand washing techniques to curb the spread of Covid-19 pandemic.

We also distributed 1000 soaps to the students of Kibera Primary.
