Frequently Asked Questions

Keeping in perspective the blockade, what provisions and services are being provided by HHRD in Palestine right now?

- HHRD has been aiding Gaza since 2013 and is currently coordinating with local partners to provide provisions stored within Gaza to the displaced individuals living in private and UN-funded schools. Despite the present siege (as of Oct 18, 2023), HHRD is preparing to respond swiftly when the blockade completely ends, by procuring non-perishable goods from nearby countries. We aim to be ready with supplies when the blockade is fully lifted.

If I contribute to HHRD right now, where & when would you utilize the funds?

- Some funds will address immediate needs in Gaza through our trusted partners. We anticipate that a substantial increase in relief efforts will be needed when the siege ends, so a portion of these funds is being used to procure dignity packages from neighboring countries for future aid. These generous contributions will have a long-term impact as humanitarian needs persist in the coming weeks and years.

Are your own staff and operation are on the ground or are you offering services through partner organizations in the field?

- HHRD has its own INGO registration in Jordan, and the HHRD Jordan (MENA) team collaborates closely with the HHRD USA team to coordinate with trusted partner organizations for an effective donor-driven response.

Do you have the capacity and commitment to provide prompt reports of the provisions and services provided on behalf of your benefactors?

- HHRD ensures donor rights, including proper reporting. This is achieved through newsletters, social media updates, websites (www.HHRD.Org/Palestine2023), and direct engagement with stakeholders and supporters.
