A living wage can not only relieve stress, but it can enable entire families to escape intergenerational poverty. Successful entrepreneurs hire other people, doubling the impact of any charitable donation. In places where women are severely restricted, home-based businesses allow them to contribute to the family's economic wellbeing and recover some sense of pride. Widows often find themselves without a means to put food on the table, and mastering handicrafts allows them to attend to domestic duties while still earning some money.

Pakistan

Transforming Lives Through Comprehensive Skills Development







In Pakistan, over 18 million people face unemployment and 38.8% of the population lives in multidimensional poverty. Our comprehensive network of 20 Skills Development and Livelihood Centers provide diverse training opportunities that prepare graduates for Pakistan's growing non-agriculture sectors. From fashion design and computer technology to technical trades and personal development, we're equipping 5,000 annual graduates with market-relevant skills that lead to formal employment and entrepreneurship opportunities in underserved communities.

Programs Offered:

- Fashion & Design Dress making, fashion designing, pattern drafting, and product development
- Technology & Computing Basic to professional computer skills, graphic design, digital marketing, and freelancing
- Technical Trades Plumbing, electrical work, mobile repair, solar panel installation, and CCTV systems
- Personal Development English language, personal grooming, art & craft, and food preservation
- Specialized Programs Enterprise Development, Agricultural Training, and Sports Development

Certification & Recognition: Eight centers provide officially recognized certificates from certified authorities, with remaining centers in the certification process, ensuring credibility and professional validation across Pakistan's job market.

Student Profile: Our students include unemployed youth, women facing double-digit unemployment rates, and individuals from high-poverty regions seeking pathways from informal agriculture to professional sectors.

- \$350 Sponsors one student's complete vocational training and certification
- \$1,750 Supports 5 individuals through their skills development journey
- \$27,000 Funds an entire Skills Development Center for one year, serving 250+ students
- \$50,000 Supports multiple centers with enterprise development programs and business start-up support



Community Based Olive Farming Program

Providing comprehensive agricultural training and olive cultivation support to transform Pakistan's marginalized farming communities. Through innovative grafting techniques, sustainable farming practices, and market development, we're empowering farmers to establish profitable olive orchards on previously barren lands. Each farmer receives specialized olive cultivation training, 50 grafted olive plants, essential farming tools, and 24 months of technical follow-up visits to ensure sustainable agricultural transformation and long-term income generation. This program directly addresses Pakistan's \$3-4 billion annual edible oil import deficit while promoting climatefriendly agriculture. Olive trees require minimal water, thrive on marginal lands, and contribute to environmental restoration in previously unproductive areas.

- \$300 Sponsors one farmer's complete olive farming setup, training, and two-year support

- \$48,000 Funds the complete program for 200 vulnerable farming families, creating lasting agricultural transformation and contributing to Pakistan's food security



Enterprise Development Program





The Enterprise Development Program operates across 17 districts in all provinces, providing comprehensive business training and in-kind support to establish microenterprises for Pakistan's most marginalized communities. Through practical business plan development, technical skills training, and market linkage facilitation, we're empowering entrepreneurs to create sustainable income sources. Each entrepreneur receives 3-4 days of business training, technical skills development, startup equipment, promotional materials, and 12 months of monthly follow-up visits to ensure business sustainability and growth.

- Enterprise Development Training Business planning, marketing techniques, basic literacy & numeracy, and bookkeeping
- Technical Skills Training Tailored 2-day to 3-month programs based on individual business needs
- In-Kind Business Support Provision of equipment, supplies, and startup materials per approved business plans
- Market Linkage Development Connecting entrepreneurs with local markets and customer networks
- Business Types Supported Trade shops, home-based tailoring, livestock, fruit/ vegetable carts, rickshaws, beauty parlors, and innovative enterprises

Beneficiary Profile: Our entrepreneurs are primarily women-headed households, differently-abled individuals, daily wage laborers, small-scale farmers, and members of religious minorities seeking economic independence and community empowerment.

- \$800 Sponsors one entrepreneur's complete training, equipment, and first-year support
- \$4,000 Supports 5 marginalized individuals to establish sustainable businesses
- \$16,000 Empowers 20 entrepreneurs across multiple provinces
- \$50,000 Funds comprehensive enterprise development for 73 vulnerable families, creating lasting economic transformation



Strengthening Small-Scale Agriculture for Food Security





In Pakistan's agriculture-dependent economy, climate change has devastated crop yields. Small-scale farmers face critical challenges including water scarcity, soil degradation, limited access to quality seeds and fertilizers. HHRD's Agricultural Program operates across Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, empowering small-scale farmers through climate-resilient practices, modern technology adoption, and sustainable livelihood strategies. We're transforming traditional single-crop farming into diversified, productive agricultural systems that ensure food security and economic sustainability.

Programs Offered:

- Climate-Resilient Farming Soil and water conservation, organic farming, integrated nutrient and pest management
- Agricultural Infrastructure Water channel rehabilitation, solar tubewell systems, and laser land leveling
- Crop Diversification Multi-cropping systems, vegetable model farms, fruit plantation, and kitchen gardening
- Capacity Building Farmer training programs, modern agricultural technology adaptation, and extension services
- Market Integration Value chain development, market linkages connecting farmers with wholesalers and retailers

Beneficiary Profile: Our farmers are small-scale agricultural households practicing traditional farming methods.

- \$1,300 Sponsors one farmer's complete agricultural transformation including training, inputs, and equipmentinputs, and equipment
- \$6,500 Supports 5 farming families to adopt climate-resilient practices
- \$26,000 Empowers 20 farmers with diversified agricultural systems
- \$50,000 Transforms 43 small-scale farms into productive, sustainable agricultural enterprises

Cricket Skills Development

Our "Let's Catch Them Young" Cricket Skills Development Program transforms young athletes through comprehensive development. Operating in Karachi, we provide structured coaching, professional equipment, and life skills training to Under-15 boys, creating pathways to competitive excellence while building character, discipline, and leadership qualities essential for success.

Programs Offered:

- Foundation Stage Basic cricket skills, fitness development, and fundamental techniques
- Specialization Stage Advanced coaching, position-specific training, and tactical development
- Competition Stage Tournament participation, performance analysis, and elite skill refinement
- Life Skills Development Character building, leadership training, and personal development sessions
- Equipment & Facilities Professional cricket gear, training equipment, and access to quality facilities

Beneficiary Profile: Our participants are talented young cricketers aged 15 and under from underserved communities in Karachi.

- \$650 Sponsors one young athlete's complete cricket development program including coaching, equipment, and life skills
- \$3,250 Supports 5 promising cricketers through their comprehensive development journey
- \$13,000 Empowers 20 young athletes with professional cricket training and equipment
- \$50,000 Transforms the lives of 89 young cricketers, building future champions and community leaders



Afghanistan

Essential Skills Training for Orphans and Vulnerable Youth





In Afghanistan, our general Skills Development and Livelihood Program serves orphans and vulnerable individuals aged 16 and above who need practical skills to build sustainable livelihoods. Operating through multiple training centers, we provide comprehensive vocational education that combines technical skills with business readiness.

Programs Offered:

- Computer Skills Microsoft Office package training for administrative and business applications
- English Language Communication skills for expanded employment and business opportunities
- Professional Tailoring Complete garment construction and textile skills for fashion and household goods production
- Mobile Device Repair Technical training in smartphone and mobile device troubleshooting and repair services

Certification & Recognition: All graduates receive officially recognized certificates that provide credibility and validation for employment opportunities throughout Afghanistan.

Student Profile: Our participants are primarily orphans and economically disadvantaged youth aged 16 and above who need practical skills to support themselves and contribute to their families' well-being.

Business Support: Graduates from tailoring and mobile repair programs receive comprehensive business start-up kits to immediately begin generating income through their newly acquired skills.

- \$350 Sponsors one student's complete skills training, certification, and tools
- \$500 Provides a toolkit for business startup for one student
- \$3,500 Trains 10 students in essential livelihood skills
- \$10,000 Funds comprehensive program operations for an entire training center, serving the most vulnerable members of Afghan society



Food Security & Livelihood Program



HHRD's Food Security and Livelihood Program provides intensive support for youth who serve as primary breadwinners for their families—those who have lost their fathers or are living with disabilities. This program combines advanced technical skills training with ongoing food support, recognizing that these vulnerable individuals carry the weight of supporting entire households in a conflict-affected economy. Every participant receives skills training, business start-up tools, official certification, AND monthly food baskets.

Programs Offered:

- Mobile Device Repair Advanced technical training in smartphone and mobile device troubleshooting and repair services
- Professional Tailoring Complete garment construction and textile skills for fashion and household goods production
- Generator Repair Mechanical training for power generation equipment maintenance and repair Motorbike Repair Comprehensive motorcycle maintenance and repair services training
- Computer/Laptop Repair Technical training in computer hardware troubleshooting and repair
- Electrical Services Professional electrician training for residential and commercial electrical work
- Poultry Management Complete training in chicken raising, egg production, and poultry business management

Certification & Recognition: All graduates receive officially recognized certificates that provide credibility and validation for employment opportunities throughout Afghanistan.

Student Profile: Participants are youth breadwinners supporting families affected by loss, disability, or economic hardship—individuals who carry responsibility for their families' survival and well-being.

- \$700 Sponsors one participant and their family with training and food support
- \$3,500 Supports 5 participants and their families
- \$14,000 Trains 20 family breadwinners
- \$30,000 Provides comprehensive program operations serving 50 youth & families



Bangladesh

Building Hope

In Bangladesh, over 1.2 million Rohingya refugees live in overcrowded camps alongside host communities struggling with poverty and limited opportunities. Our centers provide comprehensive vocational training that transforms lives. With six operational centers and a proven track record of 6,000+ graduates, we're creating sustainable pathways from dependency to dignity. Our unique model combines hands-on training with real production experience, ensuring graduates don't just learn skills—they earn while they learn.

Programs Offered:

- Tailoring and Dress Making Complete garment production with 75% employment success rate
- Industrial Sewing Machine Operation
- Jute Ware Operation
- Block-Boutique and Handicraft Production
- Soap and Hygiene Product Manufacturing
- Computer and ICT Applications

Certification & Recognition: All graduates receive official certificates recognized by the Inter Sector Coordination Group (ISCG) and relevant United Nations agencies, valid in both home and host countries.

Student Profile: Our students include Rohingya refugees, survivors of Gender Based Violence and extremely poor host community members.

- \$350 Sponsors one student's complete training, certification, and startup support
- \$500 provides one business startup toolkit
- \$7,000 Provides comprehensive support for 20 students annually
- \$60,000 Funds an entire training center for one year, serving 200+ students with production opportunities.



Healing and Empowerment for Gender-Based Violence Survivors



In the Rohingya refugee camps of Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh, over 745,000 refugees face extreme vulnerability after fleeing systematic violence and human rights abuses. Among the most vulnerable are women and girls who are survivors of gender-based violence. Our specialized Skills Development and Livelihood Program provides comprehensive support through 5 Women Friendly Spaces, offering a holistic approach that combines trauma-informed psychosocial care with practical skills training, enabling graduates to rebuild their lives with dignity and economic independence.

Vocational Skills Training - Handicraft and beading, traditional Nakshi Kantha stitching, tailoring and sewing, and modern solar panel and gas stove installation and maintenance.

Business Development - Start-up kits including sewing machines and seed capital, product purchasing programs to create immediate income opportunities, and market linkage support within camp economies.

Trauma-Informed Approach: All programming integrates specialized support for survivors of sexual violence, trafficking, and severe trauma, with qualified psychologists providing both individual therapeutic intervention and group healing sessions that reduce isolation and build community resilience among participants.

- \$500 Provides one business start up kit
- \$1,725 Provides complete handicraft training, materials, psychosocial support and business start-up for one survivor
- \$35,000 Operates one complete Women Friendly Space for one year, serving
 80+ survivors with comprehensive programming and trauma-informed care



Africa



Across Kenya, Somalia, and Tanzania, youth unemployment is reaching critical levels in communities recovering from conflicts and instability. Our network of Skills Development and Livelihood Centers strategically located throughout East Africa provides essential vocational training that directly addresses local market demands. All centers are registered with relevant local authorities and provide officially recognized certificates.

Programs Offered:

- Information Communication Technology (ICT)
- Electronics & Mobile Phone Repair
- Tailoring & Embroidery
- Henna Artistry
- Baking & Culinary Arts
- Cooking

Student Profile: Our students include unemployed youth seeking alternatives to limited formal job markets, women developing income-generating skills in male-dominated economies, and individuals from conflict-affected regions building sustainable livelihoods through practical training.

Business Development Support: Graduates receive comprehensive business start-up kits for all program areas, including ICT equipment, henna supplies, baking tools, tailoring machines, and electronics repair equipment.

- \$250 Sponsors one student's complete vocational training and certification
- \$500 Provides business startup kit for one student
- \$1,000 Supports 4 individuals through their skills development journey across East Africa
- \$35,000 Funds an entire Skills Development Center for one year, serving 150-350 students depending on location

Cambodia

Floating Hope for Fishermen Families





In Cambodia's river communities, generations of fishermen face a unique challenge. Living entirely on deteriorating boats in Kandal province, these families depend on daily fishing to survive. They earn just \$5-7.50 per day, not enough to pay for repairs. Our livelihood boat program provides sturdy, purpose-built vessels that serve as both home and workplace for Cambodia's most vulnerable people.

Programs Offered:

- Livelihood Boats Sturdy vessels designed for fishing operations and family living
- Fishing Equipment Complete sets of nets, tools, and materials for sustainable fishing
- Family Stability Permanent floating homes that enable children's education and community connection

Student Profile: Our beneficiaries are landless fishermen families living entirely on Cambodia's rivers, including elderly fishermen and families with children who risk dropping out of school due to constant movement.

- \$3,000 Provides one complete livelihood boat for an entire fishermen family
- \$15,000 Supports 5 families with safe, productive floating homes
- \$30,000 Transforms 10 families' lives with sustainable fishing operations
- \$50,000 Serves an entire river community with 20 livelihood boats, supporting 120+ individuals



Indonesia

Digital Skills for Economic Transformation



In Indonesia, Southeast Asia's largest economy, a digital revolution is creating unprecedented opportunities—but many young people from low-income backgrounds are being left behind. Our technology training center equips underprivileged youth with high-demand digital skills that directly respond to Indonesia's booming tech sector. Through intensive training in UI/UX design and data analytics, combined with mentoring and job placement services, we're preparing the next generation for meaningful careers in Indonesia's digital future while promoting inclusive economic development.

Programs Offered:

- UI/UX Design Comprehensive user interface and experience design training for digital platforms
- Data Analytics Professional data analysis skills for business intelligence and decision-making
- Workplace Readiness Soft skills development and professional mentoring for career success

Certification & Recognition: All graduates receive officially recognized certificates that provide credibility and validation in Indonesia's competitive technology job market, ensuring immediate employment opportunities.

Student Profile: Our students are primarily youth from low-income and underserved backgrounds who would otherwise be excluded from Indonesia's growing digital opportunities despite having strong potential.

In Malaysia, the food service industry, particularly artisan baking, represents a growing sector with significant potential for small business development and entrepreneurship. Our specialized bakery training program provides comprehensive hands-on education in professional baking techniques. Students learn how to create quality baked goods, and receive equipment needed to launch their own bakery businesses. With expert instruction from government-certified academy teachers, we're building a foundation for economic independence through culinary entrepreneurship.

Programs Offered:

- Professional Bakery Training Comprehensive baking techniques from basic to advanced levels
- Business Operations Essential skills for running a successful bakery enterprise
- Product Development Recipe creation and artisan baking specialization

Certification & Recognition: Graduates receive certificates from instructors who are officially recognized by government-appointed academies, ensuring credibility and professional validation in Malaysia's competitive food service market.

Despite Thailand's growing economy, these women encounter educational limitations, language challenges, and exclusion from formal labor markets, leaving them heavily dependent on humanitarian aid.

Our culinary skills training center provides practical, marketrelevant education that transforms lives. Women learn not just cooking techniques, but gain the confidence and credibility needed to launch their own food businesses. With comprehensive business support and flexible training schedules, we're creating sustainable pathways to financial self-reliance that honor their resilience and determination.

Programs Offered:

- Culinary Skills Development Comprehensive cooking training with business application focus
- Business Planning & Marketing Essential entrepreneurship skills for food service ventures
- Recipe Development Traditional and modern cooking techniques with professional presentation



Certification & Recognition: Graduates receive certificates that provide valuable credibility in the marketplace. While not government-recognized, these certificates serve as powerful evidence of skills and commitment, supporting women when opening businesses and seeking community support.

Student Profile: Our students are primarily vulnerable women seeking financial independence—including Thai women facing economic hardship, Rohingya refugees, and Burmese migrants navigating systemic barriers to employment.

Haiti

From plumbing and solar energy installation to textile production, we're equipping students with practical abilities that serve both individual economic advancement and community development in one of the world's most challenging environments.

- Sewing Machine Operation Textile production skills for Haiti's manufacturing sector

Student Profile: Our students are primarily youth and vulnerable populations seeking to develop practical skills for stable employment despite Haiti's challenging economic conditions and high unemployment rates.

English Language and Digital Skills for Economic Empowerment





In Mexico, HHRD focuses on essential language and digital skills that open doors to better employment opportunities. Our programs target skills that are immediately applicable in Mexico's growing service and technology sectors.

Students develop proficiency in English for Employment and Degree Completion, along with critical digital literacy skills including Digital Income Training, Barbering, and Mobile Phone Repair. These practical skills provide immediate earning potential while building foundations for career advancement and entrepreneurship.

Programs Offered:

- English for Employment and Degree Completion Language skills for professional advancement and academic achievement
- Digital Income Training Online earning strategies and digital entrepreneurship skills
- Barbering Professional grooming services training with immediate income potential

- Tailoring & Sewing Comprehensive garment construction, alterations, and textile skills for fashion and household goods production

Student Profile: Our 50 expected graduates this year are individuals from local communities seeking to develop practical skills that can immediately translate into income-generating activities and small business opportunities.



Our comprehensive training programs focus on handicrafts, sewing, and beauty services—skills that translate directly into income-generating opportunities within refugee communities and local markets.

Programs Offered:

- Sewing (Beginner & Advanced) Garment construction and tailoring for local markets
- Embroidery (Beginner & Advanced) Traditional and modern decorative needlework
- Handicrafts Knitting, accessories, beadwork, mud crafts, and macramé production
- Women's Hairstyling Beauty services for community-based clientele
- Detergent Production Small-scale manufacturing of household cleaning products

Certification & Recognition: Certification process is currently in progress with official accreditation expected within three months. Even with future accredited certificates, students use skills primarily for home-based work due to work permit requirements.

Student Profile: Our beneficiaries are primarily refugees and vulnerable Jordanians seeking economic independence.
