

Building Futures Through Education

The Education Support Program (ESP) is HHRD's global commitment to breaking the cycle of poverty through accessible, high-quality education. While the Orphan Support Program focuses on orphaned children within family clusters and their overall well-being, ESP casts a wider net supporting any child whose education is threatened by poverty, displacement, disability, or crisis.

From Rohingya refugee camps in Bangladesh to Syrian refugee children in Jordan, from teacher training network in Pakistan to youth leadership programs in Africa, ESP ensures that crisis does not end a child's dreams.

The Global Crisis in Education

Education remains out of reach for millions:

- 244 million children worldwide are out of school
- Refugee children are 5x more likely to be out of school
- Families living on less than \$5/day cannot afford fees, uniforms, or transportation
- Post disaster communities lose entire school systems
- Girls face cultural and economic barriers
- Youth in low-income countries rarely reach university

Without intervention, these children face a lifetime of poverty.

ESP intervenes where traditional systems fail — ensuring that poverty, displacement, or crisis does not determine a child's future.



How ESP Works: A Comprehensive, Life Changing Model

1. Immediate Educational Access

- Tuition and exam fees
- Uniforms, shoes, books, bags, stationery
- Transportation support
- Daily nutrition (breakfast, lunch, snacks)
- Ration in places of need
- Need based interventions
- Back to school campaigns
- Learning Centers for out of school students
- Laptop distributions

2. Removing Economic Barriers

- Family stipends when children would otherwise work
- Winter kits and seasonal support
- Emergency educational assistance through ESP General Support

3. Infrastructure Development

- Learning Centers in refugee camps through Shelter Relief Program
- School repairs and modular classrooms
- Furniture, digital technology, and portable internet equipment

4. Teacher Training & Capacity Building. ESP strengthens entire education systems through systems like:

- Baithak Teacher Training Network (Pakistan)
- Classroom management workshops
- Curriculum support
- Professional development for rural and refugee camp teachers

5. Higher Education Support Program (HESP): Full university scholarships covering tuition only and HHIRS (HHRD Rehabilitation Sciences) Scholarship Program for HHRD orphans which includes full- ride scholarship covering:

- Tuition
- Hostel
- Food
- Medical care
- Laptops
- Pocket money
- Career counseling & internships

ESP operates in 20+ countries, including:

In 2025, 10 HHRD sponsored orphans graduated with DPT and BS degrees from the HHRD supported rehabilitation institute (HHIRS). These graduates will now uplift their families and serve their communities as healthcare professionals.

Higher Education Support Program (HESP): A Global Game Changer

HHRD is one of the very few global nonprofits providing full ride university scholarships to orphans.

- 60% of Orphan Support Program graduates (from a pool of 28,000 orphans) enter college and university through HESP.
- Most come from large families earning less than \$5/day.
- Their earning potential increases by up to 100x after graduation.
- These first-generation graduates lift entire households out of poverty.





The Ripple Effect

HHRD alumni:

- Support siblings' education
- Strengthen local economies
- Become community leaders
- Often return as donors and volunteers
