## HHRD Programs: Dignified, Durable, and Designed for Local Realities

Across the world, families uprooted by war, persecution, and natural disasters face the same unbearable reality; without safe shelter, every other aspect of life collapses. Children cannot sleep. Parents cannot work. The elderly and disabled remain exposed to the harsh elements. Privacy, safety, and dignity disappear.

Helping Hand for Relief and Development's Shelter Relief Program (SRP) exists to change that reality — one home, one family, one community at a time.

For more than 21 years, SRP has provided permanent and temporary shelter solutions that protect families, restore stability, and help communities rebuild after crisis. With 15,083 structures built and 138,015 lives impacted, SRP is one of HHRD's most transformative programs.

Today, the need is greater than ever — and your partnership can help families reclaim the dignity of a safe home.



## The Crisis in Safe Shelter

Today, millions of families are displaced by conflict, floods, earthquakes, and economic collapse. Many live in makeshift tents, unfinished structures, or unsafe ruins. These conditions expose them to:

- Severe weather
- Disease and contaminated water
- Theft, exploitation, and violence
- Interrupted schooling
- Loss of livelihood
- Long-term trauma
- Child labor
- Early marriages

For families who have already lost everything, the absence of shelter is not just a hardship — it is a barrier to survival. HHRD responds where the need is most urgent, prioritizing communities facing displacement, poverty, and disaster.

## SRP provides three core types of shelter solutions, each tailored to the needs of the community



### 1. Temporary & Emergency Shelter

High-quality tents for displaced families, like in Gaza and other crisis zones. These tents include flooring, windows, and secure doors providing immediate safety and protection.



### 2. Caravan Homes

Weather-resistant steel units for refugees and IDPs returning to their own land in Syria. These caravans are placed directly near original homes that have been destroyed, allowing families to rebuild within their own communities while maintaining dignity, privacy, and proximity to their land.

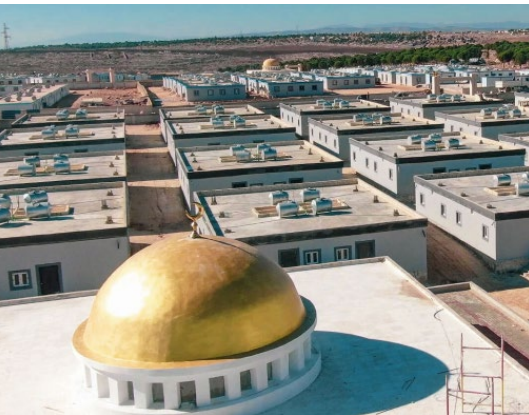


### 3. Permanent Homes

Brick-and-mortar homes built for flood survivors in Pakistan, earthquake-affected families in Afghanistan and Northern Syria. These homes are constructed on-site using approved materials and local labor, ensuring quality and sustainability. Each of these homes also has a solar system installed for efficient energy solutions.

# How We Select Beneficiaries

**SRP prioritizes families with the greatest vulnerability:**

- Large families' households with many children
- Elderly or disabled members
- Widowed or female-headed households
- Refugees and displaced families
- Those living in unsafe or uninhabitable structures

## Impact 2025

**1,356 structures built and solar panels delivered this year!**



### ASIA

- Pakistan: 50 permanent homes delivered in Swat and 1 school renovation in Chitral.
- Afghanistan: 29 homes delivered and 774 solar panels installed.
- Bangladesh: 301 shelter homes for Rohingya refugees



### MENA

- Northern Syria: 100 caravan homes delivered
- Palestine: 66 homes pending delivery
- Jordan & Lebanon: 8 Learning Centers delivered



### ASEAN

- Cambodia: 10 weather-resistant homes for poor fishing families
- Fiji: 1 community center

# Lifetime Impact

- 15,083 structures built
- 138,015 beneficiaries served
- 21 years of service across 11 countries



HHRD provided shelter solutions in partnership with UNHCR for Syrian refugees in Zaatri Camp, Jordan from 2016–2024. Starting in 2025, we are redirecting this project to support Syrian refugees returning home, giving them a safe space to rebuild their lives. Established caravan learning centers in Jordan continue to provide educational opportunities for out of school children. We also support local internally displaced people in Syria.

# Stories of Transformation

## Gaza - A Tent That Brought Back Safety



When Noha, Adi, Yousef, and Yahya's home was destroyed, they slept under rubble for weeks. SRP provided a high-quality tent with flooring, windows, and a secure door — giving them safety, warmth, and the first peaceful sleep they had experienced since the bombing.

## Cambodia - A Family's First Real Home



Soem Sy and Him Kimash lived with their four children in a fragile lean-to. In 2024, SRP built a durable, elevated home that protects them from storms and flooding.
